BELGIUM

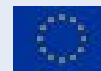
- New funding awarded to NGOs combating antisemitism, mandatory Holocaust education implemented
- New Observatory for School Climate created with 200 school pilot projects launched

HUNGARY

- National Coordinator on Antisemitism appointed in December 2022

- 2024 summit to tackle online antisemitism
- Chancellor's office launches new initiative with media on online hate
